

From 1881 until the 1930s, Fort Lytton was Brisbane's front line of defence and is regarded as the birthplace of Queensland's military history. This classic example of a coastal fortress was surrounded by a water-filled moat, and its heavy armaments were concealed behind grassy ramparts connected by underground passages. After World War II, the fort had outlived its usefulness and fell into disrepair until petroleum refining company Ampol took over the site in 1963. The fort became a national park in 1988 which today protects this important link with our military past. As a result of the considerable media publicity which followed, the Canberra was displayed at the new "Pioneer Valley Park" horse-drawn vehicle museum at Kuraby on 2nd June 1974 thus inaugurating the Queensland Air Museum.
